Monday's at 9am in the Kindy Room 13. If you have children from birth to 4 years of age, please come along and join in the fun.

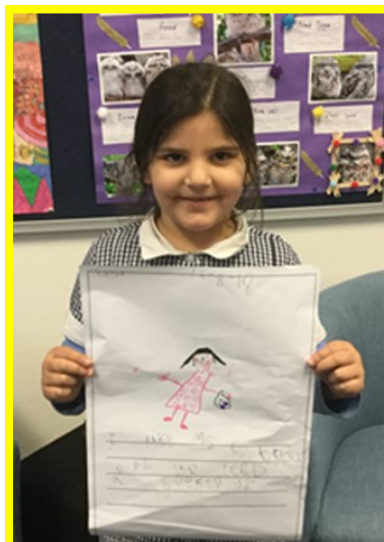


### **Good Work**
